A. The Name (5:41) **
- [a] 2. According to Acts chapter 5: verse 7, who came in?
A. Ananias' wife (5:7) **
- [g] 3. What did the officers find securely locked?
A. The jail (5:23) **
- [g] 4. With what did Ananias keep back part of the money for himself?
A. With his wife's full knowledge (5:2) **
- [s] 5. Situation question: Who said it, to whom, and what was the reply: "Tell me, is this the price you and Ananias got for the land?"
A. Peter said it to Sapphira [OR Ananias' wife], and she said, "Yes, that is the price" (5:8) **
- [g] 6. Who was honored by all the people?
A. A Pharisee named Gamaliel, a teacher of the law (5:34) **
- [g] 7. What did Gamaliel advise the Sanhedrin in the present case?
A. "Leave these men alone! Let them go!" (5:38)
- [g] 8. When did Ananias fall down and die?
A. When he heard this (5:5) **
- [a] 9. According to Acts chapter 5: verse 17, who were filled with jealousy?
A. The high priest and all his associates, who were members of the party of the Sadducees (5:17) **
- [s] 10. Situation question: Who said it, to whom, and in what situation: "Ananias, how is it that Satan has so filled your heart that you have lied to the Holy Spirit and have kept for yourself some of the money you received for the land?"
A. Peter said it to Ananias, when he sold a piece of property and, with his wife's full knowledge, kept back part of the money for himself, but brought the rest and put it at the apostles' feet (5:3-4)
- [g] 11. Who were made to appear before the Sanhedrin?
A. The apostles (5:27) **
- [a] 12. According to Acts chapter 5: verse 6, what did some young men do?
A. Came forward, wrapped up Ananias' body, and carried him out and buried him (5:6)
- [g] 13. What did Gamaliel's speech do?
A. Persuaded the Sanhedrin (5:40) **
- [a] 14. According to Acts chapter 5: verse 10, who came in?
A. The young men (5:10) **
- [g] 15. Who were furious and wanted to put the apostles to death?
A. The Sanhedrin (5:33)
- [a] 16. According to Acts chapter 5: verse 30, who raised Jesus from the dead?
A. The God of our ancestors (5:30) **
- [x] 17. Two-part question: Who did not use force, and why?
A. 1) The captain and his officers, and 2) because they feared that the people would stone them (5:26) ***
- [g] 18. Who were highly regarded by the people?
A. All the believers (5:13) **
- [g] 19. Who arrested the apostles and put them in the public jail?
A. The high priest and all his associates (5:17-18) **
- [g] 20. To what might Jesus bring Israel?
A. Repentance (5:31) **

A. A Pharisee named Gamaliel said it to the Sanhedrin [OR to the men of Israel] (5:35) **
- [g] 2. Whom did the God of our ancestors raise from the dead?
A. Jesus (5:30) **
- [g] 3. To what were more and more men and women added?
A. The believers' number (5:14) **
- [g] 4. What did a man named Ananias, together with his wife Sapphira also sell?
A. A piece of property (5:1) **
- [a] 5. According to Acts chapter 5: verse 42, what is Jesus?
A. The Messiah (5:42) **
- [g] 6. Who sent to the jail for the apostles?
A. The high priest and his associates (5:21) **
- [a] 7. According to Acts chapter 5: verse 22, where did they arrive?
A. At the jail (5:22)
- [s] 8. Situation question: Who said it, to whom, and when: "We gave you strict orders not to teach in this name, yet you have filled Jerusalem with your teaching and are determined to make us guilty of this man's blood"?
A. The high priest said it to the apostles when they were brought before the Sanhedrin to be questioned by him (5:27-28)

A. God (5:38-39)

A. Sapphira [OR Ananias' wife] (5:8) **
- [g] 11. By whom were the believers highly regarded?
A. The people (5:13)
- [g] 12. Who used to meet together in Solomon's Colonnade?
A. All the believers (5:12) **
- [a] 13. According to Acts chapter 5: verse 25, where were they standing?
A. In the temple courts (5:25)
- [g] 14. Who gathered from the towns around Jerusalem?
A. Crowds (5:16) **
- [a] 15. According to Acts chapter 5: verse 36, who was killed?
A. Theudas (5:36) **
- [g] 16. Where did the high priest and all his associates put the apostles?
A. In the public jail (5:17-18) **

A. The high priest and all his associates (5:17) **

A. Peter and the other apostles (5:29) **

A. Some young men (5:6) **
- [x] 3. Two-part question: How did the officers find the jail, and whom did they find inside?
A. 1) Securely locked, with the guards standing at the doors, and 2) no one (5:23)
- [g] 4. Who did not use force?
A. The captain and his officers (5:26) **
- [a] 5. According to Acts chapter 5: verse 14, who were added to their number?
A. More and more men and women (5:14) **
- [g] 6. How did the apostles leave the Sanhedrin?
A. Rejoicing (5:41) **
- [g] 7. Who said, "We gave you strict orders not to teach in this name, yet you have filled Jerusalem with your teaching and are determined to make us guilty of this man's blood"?
A. The high priest (5:28) **
- [a] 8. According to Acts chapter 5: verse 37, who appeared?
A. Judas the Galilean (5:37) **

A. The rest (of the money) (5:2) **

For if their purpose or activity is of human origin, it will fail. But if it is from God, you will not be able to stop these men; you will only find yourselves fighting against God"?
A. A Pharisee named Gamaliel said it to the Sanhedrin and his speech persuaded them. They called the apostles in and had them flogged. Then they ordered them not to speak in the name of Jesus, and let them go (5:38-40)

A. On hearing this report (5:24) **
- [s] 12. Situation question: Who said it, to whom, and in response to what: "How could you conspire to test the Spirit of the Lord? Listen! The feet of the men who buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out also"?
A. Peter said it to Sapphira [OR Ananias' wife] in response to her saying, "Yes, that is the price" (5:9)
- [g] 13. Who said, "Go, stand in the temple courts, and tell the people all about this new life"?
A. An angel of the Lord (5:20) **
- [g] 14. What seized the whole church and all who heard about these events?
A. Great fear (5:11) **
- [a] 15. According to Acts chapter 5: verse 19, what did an angel of the Lord do?
A. Opened the doors of the jail during the night and brought them out (5:19)
- [g] 16. What was at Ananias' disposal?
A. The money (5:4) **
- [a] 17. According to Acts chapter 5: verse 32, of what are we witnesses?
A. These things (5:32) **
- [g] 18. Who was buried beside her husband?
A. Sapphira (5:10) **
- [a] 19. According to Acts chapter 5: verse 12, what did the apostles do?
A. Performed many signs and wonders among the people (5:12)

A. "Look! The men you put in jail are standing in the temple courts teaching the people" (5:25)

 - A. About three hours later (5:7) **

 - A. All of them (their sick and those tormented by impure spirits) (5:16) **

 - A. Day after day (5:42) **

 - A. The men who buried her husband (5:9) **

 - A. Furious (5:33)
