A. The high priest said it to Stephen when all who were sitting in the Sanhedrin looked intently at Stephen, and they saw that his face was like the face of an angel (6:15-7:1)

[g] Who asked Stephen, "Are these charges true?"
A. The high priest (7:1) **

[a] According to Acts chapter 7: verse 2, what did Stephen reply?
A. "Brothers and fathers, listen to me! The God of glory appeared to our father Abraham while he was still in Mesopotamia, before he lived in Harran" (7:2)

[g] Before what did the God of glory appear to our father Abraham?
A. Before he lived in Harran (7:2)

[g] What did the God of glory do?
A. Appeared to our father Abraham while was still in Mesopotamia (before he lived in Harran) (7:2)

[g] Where was our father Abraham still?
A. In Mesopotamia (7:2)

[g] Who lived in Harran?
A. Our father Abraham (7:2)

[x] Two-part question: Who appeared to our father Abraham, and where?
A. 1) The God of glory, and 2) in Mesopotamia (7:2)

[s] Situation question: Who said it, to whom, and when: "Leave your country and your people, and go to the land I will show you"?
A. God said it to our father Abraham when he appeared to Abraham while he was still in Mesopotamia, before he lived in Harran (7:2-3)

[g] Where did God tell Abraham to go?
A. To the land he would show him (7:3)

[g] Where did God send Abraham after the death of his father?
A. To this land where you are now living (7:4) **

[g] After what did God send Abraham to this land where you are now living?
A. The death of his father (7:4)

[g] Where did Abraham settle?
A. In Harran (7:4)

[g] Who settled in Harran?
A. Abraham (7:4) **

[g] What did God give Abraham here?

A. No inheritance, not even enough ground to set his foot on (7:5)

[a] According to Acts chapter 7: verse 5, what did God promise?

A. That he and his descendants after him would possess the land (7:5)

[g] What did Abraham have at that time?

A. No child (7:5)

[g] When did Abraham have no child?

A. At that time (7:5)

[g] Who promised Abraham that he and his descendants after him would possess the land?

A. God (7:5) **

[g] What will Abraham's descendants be?

A. Strangers in a country not their own, enslaved and mistreated (7:6)

[g] How did God speak to Abraham?

A. In this way, "For four hundred years your descendants will be strangers in a country not their own, and they will be enslaved and mistreated." (7:6)

[g] To whom did God speak in this way?

A. Abraham (7:6)

[g] Where will Abraham's descendants be strangers?

A. In a country not their own (7:6)

[g] Who will be strangers in a country not their own?

A. Abraham's descendants (7:6) **

[x] From what Old Testament book is the following: "But I will punish the nation they serve as slaves, and afterward they will come out of that country and worship me in this place"?

A. Genesis (7:7)

[g] In what will Abraham's descendants worship God?

A. In this place (7:7)

[g] When will Abraham's descendants come out of that country and worship God in this place?

A. Afterward (7:7)

[g] Who will punish the nation Abraham's descendants serve as slaves?

A. God (7:7)

[s] Situation question: Who said it, and to whom: "But I will punish the nation they serve as slaves, and afterward they will come out of that country and worship me in this place"?
A. God said it to Abraham (7:7)

[s] Situation question: Who said it, to whom, and what happened next: "But I will punish the nation they serve as slaves and afterward they will come out of that country and worship me in this place"?
A. God said it to Abraham, and then he gave Abraham the covenant of circumcision (7:7-8)

[a] According to Acts chapter 7: verse 8, what did Abraham become?
A. The father of Isaac (7:8)

[g] Of whom did Abraham become the father?
A. Isaac (7:8)

[g] What did Abraham become?
A. The father of Isaac (7:8)

[g] When did Abraham circumcise Isaac?
A. Eight days after his birth (7:8)

[g] Who became the father of the twelve patriarchs?
A. Jacob (7:8)

[g] Who later became the father of Jacob?
A. Isaac (7:8)

[x] Three-part question: Who became the father of Isaac, who became the father Jacob, and who became the father of the twelve patriarchs?
A. 1) Abraham, 2) Isaac, and 3) Jacob (7:8)

[x] In Acts chapter 7, who were jealous?
A. The patriarchs (7:9)

[g] As what did the patriarchs sell Joseph into Egypt?
A. As a slave (7:9)

[g] Of whom were the patriarchs jealous?
A. Joseph (7:9) **

[g] Where did the patriarchs sell Joseph as a slave?
A. Into Egypt (7:9)

[g] Who were jealous of Joseph?
A. The patriarchs (7:9)

[g] Of what was Pharaoh king?
A. Egypt (7:10)

[g] From what did God rescue Joseph?

A. All his troubles (7:10)

[g] What did God enable Joseph to gain?

A. The goodwill of Pharaoh king of Egypt (7:10) **

[g] What was Pharaoh?

A. King of Egypt (7:10)

[g] Who made Joseph ruler over Egypt and all his palace?

A. Pharaoh king of Egypt (7:10)

[g] Whom did God enable to gain to the goodwill of Pharaoh king of Egypt?

A. Joseph (7:10)

[g] Whom did Pharaoh make ruler over Egypt and all his palace?

A. Joseph (7:10)

[x] Two-part question: Where did a famine strike, and what did it bring?

A. 1) All Egypt and Canaan, and 2) great suffering (7:11)

[g] What could our ancestors not find?

A. Food (7:11)

[g] Who sent our forefathers on their first visit?

A. Jacob (7:12)

[g] On what did Jacob send our forefathers?

A. Their first visit (7:12)

[g] Where was there grain?

A. In Egypt (7:12) **

[g] Who learned about Joseph's family?

A. Pharaoh (7:13)

[g] About whom did Pharaoh learn?

A. Joseph's family (7:13)

[g] When did Joseph tell his brothers who he was?

A. On their second visit (7:13)

[g] For whom did Joseph send?

A. His father Jacob and his whole family, (seventy-five in all) (7:14)

[g] When did Joseph send for his father Jacob and his whole family?

A. After this (7:14) **

[g] Who went down to Egypt?

A. Jacob (7:15) **

[g] Where did Jacob and our ancestors die?

A. In Egypt (7:15)

[a] According to Acts chapter 7: verse 16, what had Abraham bought?

A. A tomb from the sons of Hamor at Shechem for a certain sum of money (7:16)

[g] From whom did Abraham buy the tomb?

A. The sons of Hamor (7:16)

[g] What were brought back to Shechem?

A. Jacob and our fathers' bodies (7:16)

[g] Who had bought the tomb from the sons of Hamor at Shechem for a certain sum of money?

A. Abraham (7:16)

[g] As what had the number of our people in Egypt greatly increased?

A. As the time drew near for God to fulfill his promise to Abraham (7:17)

[g] What had greatly increased?

A. The number of our people in Egypt (7:17)

[g] When did a new king come to power in Egypt?

A. As the time drew near for God to fulfill his promise to Abraham (7:17-18)

[a] According to Acts chapter 7: verse 18, who came to power in Egypt?

A. A new king, to whom Joseph meant nothing (7:18)

[g] Where did a new king come to power?

A. In Egypt (7:18) **

[g] Who oppressed our ancestors by forcing them to throw out their newborn babies so that they would die?

A. A new king, to whom Joseph meant nothing (7:19)

[g] How did a new king, to whom Joseph meant nothing, oppress our ancestors?

A. By forcing them to throw out their newborn babies so that they would die (7:19)

[g] Whom did a new king, to whom Joseph meant nothing, force to throw out their newborn babies?

A. Our ancestors (7:19)

[g] With whom did a new king, to whom Joseph meant nothing, deal treacherously?

A. Our people (7:19)

[g] Who was no ordinary child?

A. Moses (7:20) **

[g] Who was born at that time?

A. Moses (7:20)

[g] What did Pharaoh's daughter do?

A. Took Moses and brought him up as her own son (7:21)

[g] As what did Pharaoh's daughter bring up Moses?

A. As her own son (7:21)

[g] Where was Moses placed?

A. Outside (7:21) **

[g] Whose daughter took Moses and brought him up as her own son?

A. Pharaoh's (7:21) **

[a] According to Acts chapter 7: verse 22, what was Moses?

A. Educated in all the wisdom of the Egyptians and powerful in speech and action (7:22)

[g] In what was Moses powerful?

A. Speech and action (7:22)

[g] Who was educated in all the wisdom of the Egyptians?

A. Moses (7:22)

[g] When did Moses decide to visit his own people, the Israelites?

A. When he was forty years old (7:23)

[g] Who decided to visit his own people, the Israelites, when he was forty years old?

A. Moses (7:23)

[a] According to Acts chapter 7: verse 24, what did Moses see?

A. One of his own people being mistreated by an Egyptian (7:24)

[g] To what did Moses go?

A. One of his own people's defense (7:24)

[g] Who saw one of his own people being mistreated by an Egyptian?

A. Moses (7:24)

[g] Whom did Moses see being mistreated by an Egyptian?

A. One of his own people (7:24)

[g] Who did not realize that God was using Moses to rescue them?

A. His own people (7:25)

[s] Situation question: Who said it, to whom, and why: "Men, you are brothers; why do you want to hurt each other?"

A. Moses said it to two Israelites who were fighting to try to reconcile them (7:26)

[g] When did Moses come upon two Israelites who were fighting?

A. The next day (7:26)

[g] Who were fighting?

A. Two Israelites (7:26) **

[g] Who pushed Moses aside?

A. The man who was mistreating the other (7:27) **

[g] Whom did the man who was mistreating the other push aside?

A. Moses (7:27)

[g] To whom did the man who was mistreating the other say, "Are you thinking of killing me as you killed the Egyptian yesterday?"

A. Moses (7:28)

[x] From what Old Testament book is the following: "Are you thinking of killing me as you killed the Egyptian yesterday?"

A. Exodus (7:28)

[x] Two-part question: Where did Moses go when he left Egypt, and what did he do there?

A. 1) To Midian, and 2) he settled as a foreigner and had two sons (7:29)

[g] How did Moses settle in Midian?

A. As a foreigner (7:29)

[g] Where did Moses settle as a foreigner?

A. Midian (7:29) **

[g] Who settled as a foreigner in Midian?

A. Moses (7:29)

[g] Where did an angel appear to Moses?

A. In the flames of a burning bush in the desert near Mount Sinai (7:30)

[a] According to Acts chapter 7: verse 30, who appeared?

A. An angel (7:30)

[g] To whom did an angel appear in the flames of a burning bush?

A. Moses (7:30)

[g] Who appeared to Moses in the flames of a burning bush?

A. An angel (7:30)
