A. To Pisidian Antioch (13:14)
- [g] Who sent word to Paul and his companions?
A. The leaders of the synagogue (13:15)
- [a] According to Acts chapter 13: verse 16, who stood up?
A. Paul (13:16) **
- [a] According to Acts chapter 13: verse 17, what did the God of the people of Israel do?
A. He chose our ancestors; he made the people prosper during their stay in Egypt, with mighty power he led them out of that country (13:17)
- [g] What did the God of the people of Israel endure for about forty years in the wilderness?
A. Their conduct (13:18)
- [g] What did the God of the people of Israel give to them as their inheritance?
A. The land of seven nations in Canaan (13:19)
- [g] What did the God of the people of Israel overthrow in Canaan?
A. Seven nations (13:19)
- [a] According to Acts chapter 13: verse 20, who did God give them?
A. Judges (until the time of Samuel the prophet) (13:20)
- [g] Who **ruled** forty years?
A. Saul son of Kish (13:21) **
- [s] Situation question: Who said it, and how: "I have found David son of **Jesse** a man after my own heart; he will do everything I want him to do"?
A. God testified it concerning him (13:22)

A. After removing Saul (13:22) **
- [g] Who will do everything God wants him to do?
A. David (son of Jesse) (13:22) **
- [g] From what has God brought to Israel the Savior Jesus, as he promised?
A. This man's descendants (13:23)
- [g] Who preached repentance and baptism to all the people of Israel?
A. John (13:24)
- [g] What did John say as he was **completing** his work?
A. "Who do you suppose I am? I am not the one you are looking for. But there is one coming after me whose sandals I am not worthy to untie." (13:25) **
- [g] Where has this message of salvation been sent?
A. To the children of Abraham, and you God-fearing Gentiles (13:26)
- [g] Of whom did the people of Jerusalem and their rulers **fulfill** the words in **condemning** Jesus?
A. The prophets (13:27)
- [g] Whom did the people of Jerusalem and their rulers not recognize?
A. Jesus (13:27)
- [g] For what did the people of Jerusalem and their rulers find no **proper** ground?
A. A death sentence (13:28)
- [g] What had the people of Jerusalem and their rulers carried out?
A. All that was written about Jesus (13:29)
- [g] From what did God raise Jesus?
A. The dead (13:30)
- [a] According to Acts chapter 13: verse 31, what are they now?
A. His (Jesus') witnesses to our people (13:31)

A. Jesus (13:31)

A. Psalms (13:33)
- [g] What has God fulfilled for us, their children, by raising up Jesus?
A. What he promised our fathers (13:32-33)
- [g] To whom were the holy and **sure blessings** promised?
A. David (13:34)
- [a] According to Acts chapter 13: verse 35, what will God not do?
A. Let his holy one see decay (13:35)
- [g] What **decayed**?
A. David's body (13:36)
- [g] Who was buried with his ancestors?
A. David (13:36) **
- [g] What is proclaimed to you through Jesus?
A. The forgiveness of sins (13:38)
- [a] According to Acts chapter 13: verse 39, what is everyone who believes?
A. Set free from every sin (13:39)
- [x] Who warned about what you should take care does not happen to you?
A. The prophets (13:40)
- [g] In what are the prophets going to do something that you would never believe, even if someone told you?
A. Your days (13:41)
- [g] When did the people invite Paul and Barnabas to speak further about these things on the next Sabbath?
A. As they were leaving (13:42)

A. The grace of God (13:43)

A. Paul and Barnabas said it to the Jews boldly (13:46)

A. The Jews (13:47)
- [g] What did all who were appointed for eternal life do?
A. Believed (13:48)
- [g] Through where did the word of the Lord spread?
A. The whole region (13:49)
- [g] What did the Jewish leaders stir up against Paul and Barnabas?
A. Persecution (13:50)
- [g] What did Paul and Barnabas do as a warning to the Jews?
A. Shook the dust off their feet (13:51)
