A. The men said it to Peter about Cornelius the centurion (10:22) **

A. A voice said it to Peter in response to Peter saying, "Surely not, Lord! I have never eaten anything impure or unclean" [OR in response to Peter saying, "Surely not, Lord! Nothing impure or unclean has ever entered my mouth"] (10:14-15; 11:8-9)
- [s] Situation question: Who said it, to whom, and in response to what: "Your **prayers** and gifts to the poor have come up as a **memorial** offering before God"?
A. An angel of God said it to Cornelius in response to him asking, "What is it, Lord?" (10:4)
- [s] Situation question: Who said it, to whom, and what was the reply: "What is it, Lord?"
A. Cornelius said it to an angel of God and he answered, "Your prayers and gifts to the poor have come up as a memorial offering before God. Now send men to Joppa to bring back a man named Simon who is called Peter. He is staying with Simon the tanner, whose house is by the sea" (10:4-6)
