 - A. All that Jesus began to do and to teach (1:1)
- [a] According to Acts chapter 1: verse 14, what was Mary?
 - A. The mother of Jesus (1:14) **
- [a] According to Acts chapter 2: verse 17, who will prophesy?
 - A. Your sons and daughters (2:17) **
- [a] According to Acts chapter 2: verse 25, what did David say?
 - A. "I saw the Lord always before me. Because he is at my right hand, I will not be shaken" (2:25)
- [a] According to Acts chapter 2: verse 3, what did they see?
 - A. What seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them (2:3) **
- [a] According to Acts chapter 2: verse 44, what were all the believers?
 - A. Together (2:44)
- [g] Before what was Jesus taken up?
 - A. Before their very eyes (1:9) **
- [x] **Complete** in essence the following: "With the **payment** he received ..."
 - A. "... for his wickedness, Judas bought a field; there he fell headlong, his body burst open and all his intestines spilled out." (1:18)
- [x] Eleven-part **answer**: Identify the 11 apostles in the upper room.
 - A. Peter, John, James, Andrew, Philip, Thomas, Bartholomew, Matthew, James son of Alphaeus, Simon the Zealot, and Judas son of James (1:13)
- [g] For what should the apostles wait?
 - A. The gift Jesus' Father promised (1:4)
- [g] From what should you **save** yourselves?
 - A. This corrupt generation (2:40)
- [g] How did each of the Jews hear the apostles **declaring** the wonders of God?
 - A. In their own tongues (2:11)
- [g] How did Peter help the man up?
 - A. Taking him by the right hand (3:7) **
- [x] How far was a Sabbath day's walk?
 - A. About 5/8 mile (or about 1 kilometer) (1:12)
- [g] Into what has this same Jesus been taken from you?
 - A. Into heaven (1:11)
- [g] Into what were the apostles looking intently?
 - A. Up into the sky (1:10)
- [g] Of what should all Israel be **assured**?
 - A. This: God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Messiah (2:36) **
- [g] Onto whom did the man who had been lame from birth hold?
 - A. Peter and John (3:11)
- [s] Situation question: Who said it, to whom, and in response to what: "Fellow Jews and all of you who live in Jerusalem, let me **explain** this to you; listen carefully to what I have to say"?
 - A. Peter said it to the crowd in response to some of them saying "They have had too much wine" (2:13-14)
- [g] To whom did Jesus present himself after his suffering and give many **convincing proofs** that he was alive?
 - A. Them [the apostles he had chosen] (1:3)
- [g] To whom did the lot fall?
 - A. Matthias (1:26) **
- [x] Two-part **answer**: What **events** began and concluded Jesus' living among the apostles?
 - A. 1) John's baptism, and 2) Jesus being taken up from the apostles (1:21-22)
- [x] Two-part **answer**: What two things will happen when the Holy Spirit comes on you?
 - A. 1) You will receive power, and 2) you will be Jesus' witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth (1:8)

- [g] What comes through Jesus?
A. Faith (3:16)
- [x] What did God foretell about the Messiah through the prophets?
A. That his Messiah would suffer (3:18)
- [g] What did Judas receive for his wickedness?
A. Payment (1:18) **
- [g] What did the believers do in their **homes**?
A. Broke bread and ate together with glad and sincere hearts (2:46)
- [g] What did the crowd ask, **utterly** amazed?
A. "Aren't all these who are speaking Galileans?" (2:7)
- [g] What did the crowd do, amazed and **perplexed**?
A. They asked one another, "What does this mean?" (2:12)
- [g] What did the man who was lame from birth give Peter and John?
A. His attention (3:5)
- [g] What did the same man used to do?
A. Sit begging at the temple gate called Beautiful (3:10)
- [g] What do the fellow Israelites themselves know?
A. That Jesus of Nazareth was a man accredited by God to them by miracles, wonders and signs, which God did among them through him (2:22)
- [g] What is glad?
A. David's heart (2:26) **
- [g] What is written in the book of **Psalms**?
A. "May his place be deserted; let there be no one to dwell in it," and, "May another take his place of leadership" (1:20)
- [g] What should every one of you do?
A. Repent and be baptized, in the name of Jesus Christ, for the forgiveness of your sins (2:38)
- [g] What signs will God show on the earth **below**?
A. Blood and fire and billows of smoke (2:19)
- [g] What was called Beautiful?
A. The temple gate (3:2) **
- [g] What was **impossible**?
A. For death to keep its hold on him (2:24)
- [g] What was Joseph called?
A. Barsabbas (1:23)
- [g] When did the Lord add to the believers' number those who were being saved?
A. Daily (2:47)
- [g] When were about three thousand added to the apostles' number?
A. That day (2:41)
- [g] When were the people cut to the heart?
A. When they heard this (2:37) **
- [g] When will the sun be turned to darkness and the moon to blood?
A. Before the coming of the great and glorious day of the Lord (2:20)
- [g] Where were God-fearing Jews from every nation under heaven staying?
A. In Jerusalem (2:5) **
- [g] Where were the apostles when the day of Pentecost came?
A. All together in one place (2:1)
- [g] Who asked Jesus, "Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?"
A. The apostles (1:6)
- [g] Who died and was buried?
A. The patriarch David (2:29) **
- [g] Who gave instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles he had chosen?
A. Jesus (1:2)

- [g] Who has poured out what you now see and hear?
A. This Jesus (2:33) ***
- [g] Who jumped to his feet and began to walk?
A. The man who was lame from birth (3:8) **
- [g] Who said, "Brothers and sisters, the Scripture had to be fulfilled in which the Holy Spirit spoke long ago through David concerning Judas, who served as **guide** for those who arrested Jesus"?
A. Peter (1:16) **
- [g] Who was Jesus of Nazareth?
A. A man accredited by God to you (fellow Israelites) by miracles, wonders and signs (2:22)
- [g] Who was not **abandoned** to the realm of the dead?
A. The Messiah (2:31) **
- [g] Who were a group **numbering** about a hundred and twenty?
A. The believers (1:15)
- [g] Who will pour out his Spirit on all people in the last days?
A. God (2:17) **
- [g] Whom did a man who was lame from birth ask for money?
A. Peter and John (3:3) **
- [g] Whom did this **surprise**?
A. Fellow Israelites (3:12)
- [g] Whom had God promised on oath?
A. David (2:30)
- [g] Whom has the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, the God of our fathers **glorified**?
A. His servant Jesus (3:13)
- [g] Whom will God not **abandon** to the realm of the dead?
A. David (2:27)
- [g] Why should you repent and turn to God?
A. So that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord, and that he may send the Messiah, who has been appointed for you (even Jesus) (3:19-20)
