

- [a] According to Acts chapter 4: verse 10, whom did God raise from the dead?
A. Jesus Christ of Nazareth (4:10) **
- [a] According to Acts chapter 4: verse 18, what did the Sanhedrin command them not to do?
A. Not to speak or teach at all in the name of Jesus (4:18)
- [a] According to Acts chapter 4: verse 34, who brought the money from the **sales** and put it at the apostles' feet?
A. Those who owned land or houses (4:34)
- [a] According to Acts chapter 4: verse 37, what did Joseph do?
A. Sold a field he owned and brought the money and put it at the apostles' feet (4:37)
- [a] According to Acts chapter 5: verse 1, what did Ananias do?
A. Also sold a piece of property (together with his wife Sapphira) (5:1)
- [a] According to Acts chapter 5: verse 10, what did the young men do?
A. Came in, and finding her dead, carried her out and buried her beside her husband (5:10)
- [a] According to Acts chapter 5: verse 30, what did the God of our ancestors do?
A. Raised Jesus from the dead (5:30)
- [a] According to Acts chapter 5: verse 32, what is the Holy Spirit?
A. A witness of these things (5:32)
- [a] According to Acts chapter 5: verse 34, who stood up?
A. A Pharisee named Gamaliel, a teacher of the law, who was honored by all the people (5:34)
- [g] Because of what did the priests and the captain of the temple guard and the Sadducees put Peter and John in jail until the next day?
A. Because it was evening (4:3)
- [g] Before whom did the captain and his officers make the apostles appear?
A. The Sanhedrin (5:27)
- [g] For what were Peter and John being called to account?
A. For an act of kindness shown to a man who was lame (4:9)
- [g] How did the apostles enter the temple courts at **daybreak**?
A. As they had been told (5:21)
- [g] How did the officers find the jail?
A. Securely locked, with the guards standing at the doors (5:23) **
- [g] In what did all the believers used to meet together?
A. In Solomon's Colonnade (5:12)
- [g] Of what were the high priest and all his associates members?
A. The party of the Sadducees (5:17)
- [g] On whom might Peter's **shadow** fall as he passed by?
A. Some of the sick (5:15) **
- [s] Situation question: Who said it, to whom, and in what situation: "By what power or what name did you do this?"
A. The rulers, the elders and the teachers of the law said it to Peter and John when they met in Jerusalem and had Peter and John brought before them and began to question them (4:7) **
- [x] Three-part question: Who **rallied** to **Theudas**, what happened to him, and what happened to his followers?
A. 1) About four hundred men, 2) he was killed, and 3) they were dispersed (5:36)
- [g] To what did **Sapphira** conspire?
A. To test the Spirit of the Lord (5:9)
- [g] To what did the apostles **continue** to testify?
A. The resurrection of the Lord Jesus (4:33)
- [g] To what might Jesus bring Israel?
A. Repentance (5:31) **
- [g] To what number did the men who believed grow?
A. About five thousand (4:4)
- [x] Two-part question: What means "son of encouragement," and who was called this by the apostles?
A. 1) Barnabas, and 2) Joseph (4:36)

- [x] Two-part question: Who rise up and who band together against the Lord and against his anointed one?
A. 1) The kings of the earth, and 2) the rulers (4:26)
- [g] What did God do by the Holy Spirit through the mouth of his servant, our father David?
A. Spoke (4:25)
- [g] What did some young men **wrap** up?
A. Ananias' body (5:6)
- [g] What did the captain and his officers fear?
A. That the people would stone them (5:26) **
- [g] What had decided **beforehand** what should happen?
A. God's power and will (4:28) **
- [g] What should the Lord **stretch** out his hand to perform?
A. Signs and wonders (4:30)
- [g] What were all Judas' followers?
A. Scattered (5:37)
- [g] What were the captain of the temple guard and the chief priests?
A. At a loss (wondering what this might lead to) (5:24)
- [g] When did an angel of the Lord open the doors of the jail and bring the apostles out?
A. During the night (5:19)
- [g] When did Ananias' wife come in?
A. About three hours later (5:7) **
- [g] When was the place where they were meeting shaken?
A. After they prayed (4:31)
- [g] When will the Sanhedrin not be able to stop these men?
A. If their purpose or activity is from God (5:38-39)
- [g] Where did an angel of the Lord tell the apostles to stand?
A. In the temple courts (5:20)
- [g] Where did Ananias put the rest?
A. At the apostles' feet (5:2)
- [g] Where is there no other name given to mankind by which we must be saved?
A. Under heaven (4:12)
- [g] Where were the guards standing?
A. At the doors (5:23) **
- [g] Who appeared some time ago, **claiming** to be **somebody**?
A. Theudas (5:36)
- [g] Who believed in the Lord and were added to the believers' number?
A. More and more men and women (5:14)
- [g] Who brought their sick and those **tormented** by impure spirits?
A. Crowds from the towns around Jerusalem (5:16) **
- [g] Who called together the Sanhedrin—the full assembly of the elders of Israel?
A. The high priest and his associates (5:21)
- [g] Who came in and, **finding Sapphira** dead, carried her out and buried her beside her husband?
A. The young men (5:10)
- [g] Who came up to Peter and John while they were speaking to the people?
A. The priests and the captain of the temple guard and the Sadducees (4:1) **
- [g] Who had filled Jerusalem with their teaching?
A. The apostles (5:28)
- [g] Who had kept for himself some of the money he received for the land?
A. Ananias (5:3)
- [g] Who had not lied just to human beings but to God?
A. Ananias (5:4)

- [g] Who is the stone you **builders** rejected, which has become the **cornerstone**?
A. Jesus Christ of Nazareth (4:10-11)
- [g] Who knew Peter and John had performed a **notable sign**?
A. Everyone living in Jerusalem (4:16)
- [g] Who raised their voices together in prayer to God?
A. Peter and John's own people (4:24) ***
- [g] Who said, "As for us, we cannot help speaking about what we have seen and heard"?
A. Peter and John (4:20)
- [g] Who was a Pharisee, a **teacher** of the law, who was honored by all the people?
A. Gamaliel (5:34)
- [g] Who went back to their own people and reported all that the chief priests and the elders had said to them?
A. Peter and John (4:23)
- [g] Who were ordered to **withdraw** from the Sanhedrin?
A. Peter and John (4:15)
- [g] Whom could the Sanhedrin not decide how to punish?
A. Peter and John (4:21) **
- [g] Why did the apostles leave the Sanhedrin rejoicing?
A. Because they had been counted worthy of suffering disgrace for the Name (5:41) **
- [g] Why was there nothing the rulers, the elders and the teachers of the law could say?
A. Since they could see the man who had been healed standing there with Peter and John (4:14)
