- [g] 1. Before what did the God of glory appear to our father Abraham?
A. Before he lived in Harran (7:2)
- [a] 2. According to Acts chapter 6: verse 5, whom did they choose?
A. Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit, also Philip, Procorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas and Nicolas from Antioch, a convert to Judaism (6:5)
- [s] 3. Situation question: Who said it, to whom, and what happened next: "Make us gods who will go before us. As for this fellow Moses who led us out of Egypt—we don't know what has happened to him!"?
A. Our ancestors said it to Aaron and they made an idol in the form of a calf. They brought sacrifices to it and reveled in what their own hands had made (7:40-41)
- [g] 4. Of whom did the believers at Lystra and Iconium speak well?
A. Timothy (16:2)
- [g] 5. Where did the apostles hear that Samaria had accepted the word of God?
A. In Jerusalem (8:14)
- [g] 6. For whom did David ask that he might provide a **dwelling** place?
A. The God of Jacob (7:46)
- [g] 7. What did those who were scattered preach **wherever** they went?
A. The word (8:4)
- [a] 8. According to Acts chapter 7: verse 37, who is this?
A. The Moses who told the Israelites, "God will raise up for you a prophet like me from you own people" (7:37)
- [s] 9. Situation question: Who said it, to whom, and what was the result: "In the name of Jesus Christ I command you to come out of her!"?
A. Paul said it to the spirit and at that moment the spirit left her (16:18)
- [g] 10. Who was blind for three days and did not eat or drink anything?
A. Saul (9:9)
- [a] 11. According to Acts chapter 8: verse 22, what did Simon have?
A. Such a thought in his heart (8:22)
- [g] 12. As what did Paul and Timothy deliver the **decisions** reached by the apostles and elders in Jerusalem for the people to obey?
A. As they traveled from town to town (16:4)
- [g] 13. What would Saul be told?
A. What he must do (9:6)
- [g] 14. Whom did the magistrates **escort** from the prison?
A. Paul and Silas (16:39)
- [a] 15. According to Acts chapter 9: verse 7, what did they hear?
A. The sound (9:7)
- [a] 16. According to Acts chapter 9: verse 5, what did Saul ask?
A. "Who are you Lord?" (9:5)
- [x] 17. What are Hellenistic Jews?
A. Jews who have adopted the Greek language and culture (6:1)
- [a] 18. According to Acts chapter 8: verse 34, what did the eunuch ask?
A. "Tell me, please, who is the prophet talking about, himself or someone else?" (8:34)
- [g] 19. Whom did the Twelve gather together?
A. All the disciples (6:2)
- [g] 20. When did the Spirit give Stephen wisdom?
A. As he spoke (6:10)

- [g] 1. Among whom did Stephen perform great wonders and signs?
A. The people (6:8)
- [a] 2. According to Acts chapter 8: verse 32, what was he reading?
A. This passage of Scripture: "He was led like a sheep to the slaughter, and as a lamb before the shearer is silent, so he did not open his mouth (8:32)
- [g] 3. How did **godly** men mourn for Stephen?
A. Deeply (8:2)
- [a] 4. According to Acts chapter 16: verse 1, to where did Paul come?
A. To Derbe and then to Lystra (16:1)
- [g] 5. What did our ancestors under **Joshua** do?
A. Brought the tabernacle with them when they took the land from the nations God drove out before them (7:45)
- [a] 6. According to Acts chapter 9: verse 26, what were the disciples?
A. Afraid of Saul (9:26)
- [g] 7. Among whom was there a conspiracy to kill Saul?
A. The Jews (9:23)
- [g] 8. After what did Paul and Silas go to Lydia's house?
A. After they came out of the prison (16:40)
- [a] 9. According to Acts chapter 6: verse 4, what will the Twelve do?
A. Give their attention to prayer and the ministry of the word (6:4)
- [x] 10. **Complete** in essence the following: "Heaven is my throne, and ..."
A. "... the earth is my footstool. What kind of house will you build for me? says the Lord. Or where will my resting place be?" (7:49)
- [s] 11. Situation question: Who said it, how, and about whom: "This man is **rightly** called the Great Power of God."
A. All the people, both high and low, exclaimed it about Simon (8:10)
- [g] 12. What grew daily in numbers?
A. The churches (16:5)
- [a] 13. According to Acts chapter 16: verse 30, what did the jailer ask?
A. "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" (16:30)
- [g] 14. How did Simon think he could **buy** the gift of God?
A. With money (8:20)
- [g] 15. Who appeared to Moses in the **flames** of a **burning** bush?
A. An angel (7:30)
- [a] 16. According to Acts chapter 6: verse 7, what spread?
A. The word of God (6:7)
- [g] 17. To whom will the Twelve turn over this **responsibility**?
A. The seven men (6:3)
- [g] 18. Who even killed those who predicted the coming of the Righteous One?
A. Your ancestors (7:52)
- [s] 19. Situation question: Who said it, to whom, and when: "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?"
A. A voice said it to Saul as he neared Damascus and a light from heaven suddenly flashed around him and he fell to the ground (9:3-4)
- [g] 20. What suddenly flashed around Saul?
A. A light from heaven (9:3)

Acts 6-9 & 16

- [g] 1. Where did Paul want to take Timothy?
A. Along on the journey (16:3)
- [g] 2. Where might Saul take any there who belonged to the Way as prisoners?
A. To Jerusalem (9:2)
- [g] 3. Whom did Saul drag off and put in prison?
A. Both men and women (8:3)
- [s] 4. Situation question: Who said it, to whom, and in what situation: "Give me also this **ability** so that everyone on whom **I lay** my hands may receive the Holy Spirit"?
A. Simon said it to the Peter and John [OR the apostles] when he saw that the Spirit was given at the laying on of the apostles' hands and he offered them money (8:18-19)
- [a] 5. According to Acts chapter 6: verse 6, what did the apostles do to these men?
A. Prayed and laid their hands on them (6:6)
- [g] 6. From what did the Holy Spirit keep Paul and his companions?
A. Preaching the word in the province of Asia (16:6)
- [a] 7. According to Acts chapter 7: verse 36, who performed wonders and signs?
A. Moses (7:36)
- [g] 8. At whom did all who were sitting in the Sanhedrin look intently?
A. Stephen (6:15)
- [s] 9. Situation question: Who said it, and to whom: "This fellow never **stops** speaking against this holy place and against the law"?
A. False witnesses said it to the Sanhedrin (6:13)
- [g] 10. At what did the jailer take Paul and Silas and **wash** their **wounds**?
A. At that hour of the night (16:33)
- [a] 11. According to Acts chapter 8: verse 1, who were scattered?
A. All except the apostles (8:1)
- [g] 12. From whom did **opposition arise**?
A. Members of the synagogue of the Freedmen (as it was called), Jews of Cyrene and Alexandria as well as the provinces of Cilicia and Asia (6:9)
- [g] 13. At what was Moses amazed?
A. The sight (7:31)
- [a] 14. According to Acts chapter 9: verse 1, where did Saul go?
A. To the high priest (9:1)
- [g] 15. At whom did the members of the Sanhedrin gnash their **teeth**?
A. Stephen (7:54)
- [a] 16. According to Acts chapter 9: verse 8, what could Saul see?
A. Nothing (9:8)
- [x] 17. Two-part question: When will Abraham's descendants come out of that country, and what will they do?
A. 1) Afterward, and 2) worship God in this place (7:7)
- [g] 18. Among whom had Saul raised **havoc** in Jerusalem?
A. Those who call on this name (Jesus) (9:21)
- [a] 19. According to Acts chapter 16: verse 38, what were Paul and Silas?
A. Roman citizens (16:38)
- [g] 20. To where did Philip go down?
A. A city in Samaria (8:5)
