- [a] According to Acts chapter 15: verse 30, who went down to Antioch?
A. The men (15:30)
- [a] According to Acts chapter 15: verse 36, for what should we go back and visit the believers in all the towns where we preached the word of the Lord?
A. To see how they are doing (15:36)
- [a] According to Acts chapter 15: verse 7, what did God make?
A. A choice among you that the Gentiles might hear from my lips the message of the gospel and believe (15:7)
- [a] According to Acts chapter 15: verse 7, who addressed them?
A. Peter (15:7) **
- [a] According to Acts chapter 15: verse 8, what did God show?
A. That he accepted them (the Gentiles) by giving the Holy Spirit to them, just as he did to us (15:8)
- [g] By what did some **trouble** the Gentiles' minds?
A. What they said (15:24)
- [g] By whom was Paul **commended**?
A. The believers (15:40)
- [g] By whom were Judas and Silas sent off with the **blessing** of peace?
A. The believers (15:33)
- [g] From what should the Gentiles abstain?
A. Food polluted by idols, sexual immorality, the meat of strangled animals and blood (15:20)
- [g] From when has the law of Moses been preached in every city?
A. The earliest times (15:21)
- [g] How did some of the believers who belonged to the party of the Pharisees **try** to test God?
A. By putting on the necks of the Gentiles a yoke that neither they nor their ancestors have been able to bear (15:10)
- [g] How were the apostles and elders sending Judas and Silas to **confirm** what they were **writing**?
A. By word of mouth (15:27)
- [g] On what did the church send Paul and Barnabas?
A. Their way (15:3)
- [s] Situation question: Who said it, how, and what was the response: "The Gentiles must be circumcised and **required** to keep the law of Moses"?
A. Some of the believers who belonged to the party of the Pharisees stood up and said it, and the apostles and elders met to consider this question (15:5-6)
- [g] Through what are we saved, just as they are?
A. The grace of our Lord Jesus (15:11)
- [g] Through whom had God done signs and wonders among the Gentiles?
A. Barnabas and Paul (15:12) **
- [g] To whom did it seem good not to **burden** the Gentiles?
A. The Holy Spirit and the apostles and elders (15:28)
- [g] To whom did Paul and Barnabas **report** everything God had done through them?
A. The church and the apostles and the elders (15:4)
- [g] What are in **agreement** with this?
A. The words of the prophets (15:15)
- [g] What did God first do?
A. Intervened to choose a people for his name from the Gentiles (15:14)

A. Discriminate (15:9)

A. Circumcised and required to keep the law of Moses (15:5)

A. "Unless you are circumcised, according to the custom taught by Moses, you cannot be saved" (15:1)

A. After much discussion (15:7)

A. Certain people (15:1)

A. The people (15:31)

A. Judas and Silas (15:22) ***
- [g] Who were sent off and went down to Antioch?
A. The men (15:30) **
- [g] Who were to abstain from food sacrificed to idols, blood, the meat of strangled animals and sexual immorality?
A. The Gentiles (15:29)
- [g] Whom did Judas and Silas say much to **encourage** and **strengthen**?
A. The believers (15:32)
- [g] Whom did Paul not think it **wise** to take?
A. John, also called Mark (15:38)
- [g] Whom did this bring into sharp dispute and debate with them?
A. Paul and Barnabas (15:2)
- [g] Why did Paul not think it **wise** to take John, also called Mark?
A. Because he had deserted them in Pamphylia and had not continued with them in the work (15:38)
- [g] Why were Paul and Barnabas, along with some other believers, appointed to go up to Jerusalem?
A. To see the apostles and elders about this question (15:2)
- [g] Why will the Lord restore David's **fallen tent**?
A. That the rest of mankind may seek the Lord, even all the Gentiles who bear his name (15:16-17)
- [g] With whom did the apostles and elders send the letter?
A. Judas and Silas (15:23)
- [g] Without what did some go out from the apostles and elders?
A. Their authorization (15:24)
