A. His companions (22:11)
- [a] 3. According to Acts chapter 22: verse 4, whom did Paul **arrest**?  
A. The followers of this Way, both men and women (22:4)
- [g] 4. To where did **certain** people come down from Judea?  
A. Antioch (15:1)
- [g] 5. Whom did some of the Jews, a large number of God-fearing Greeks, and **quite** a few **prominent** women join?  
A. Paul and Silas (17:4)

- [g] 3. What was **afoot** among both Gentiles and Jews, together with their leaders?  
A. A plot to mistreat Paul and Barnabas [OR the apostles] and stone them (14:5)
- [g] 4. Who can testify that Paul **persecuted** the followers of this Way to their death, **arresting** both men and women and throwing them into prison?  
A. The high priest and all the Council (22:4-5)
- [a] 5. According to Acts chapter 22: verse 10, what will you be told?  
A. All that you have been assigned to do (22:10)
- [g] 6. Into what were the crowd and the city **officials thrown**?  
A. Turmoil (17:8)

A. The house of Mary the mother of John (also called Mark) (12:12)
- [g] 19. What did the Lord **confirm**?  
A. The message of his grace (14:3)
- [g] 20. What did the church at Antioch do after they had **fasted** and prayed?  
A. Placed their hands on Barnabas and Saul and sent them off (13:3)

A. Timothy (16:3)

A. Paul [OR Saul] (22:12)

A. The dead (17:3)

A. Peter (12:4)

A. A tentmaker (18:3)
