A. "Brothers and fathers, listen now to my defense" (22:1)
- [g] 2. When was Paul able to see Ananias?
A. At that very moment (22:13)
- [g] 3. To whom did the Lord say, "Quick! Leave Jerusalem immediately, because the people here will not accept your testimony about me"?
A. Paul (22:18)
- [g] 4. Whom had the commander put in chains?
A. Paul, a Roman citizen (22:29) **
- [a] 5. According to Acts chapter 22: verse 24, what did the commander order?
A. That Paul be taken into the barracks (22:24) **
- [x] 6. Two-part question: Who had to pay a lot of money for his **citizenship**, and who was born a citizen?
A. 1) The commander, and 2) Paul (22:28)
- [a] 7. According to Acts chapter 22: verse 4, whom did Paul **arrest**?
A. The followers of this Way, both men and women (22:4)
- [g] 8. Who will be God's witness to all people of what he has seen and heard?
A. Paul [OR Saul] (22:15)
- [g] 9. From whom did Paul **obtain** letters to their associates in Damascus?
A. The high priest and all the council (22:5) **
- [a] 10. According to Acts chapter 22: verse 14, what did Ananias then say?
A. "The God of our ancestors has chosen you to know his will and to see the Righteous One and to hear words from his mouth" (22:14)
- [g] 11. Who did not understand the voice of him who was speaking to Paul?
A. His companions (22:9) **
- [a] 12. According to Acts chapter 22: verse 6, where did Paul come?
A. Near Damascus (22:6)
- [s] 13. Situation question: Who said it, and to whom: "Go, I will send you far away to the Gentiles"?
A. The Lord said it to Paul (22:21) **
- [g] 14. When did the crowd become very quiet?
A. When they heard Paul speak to them in Aramaic (22:2) **
- [g] 15. Until when did the crowd listen to Paul?
A. Until he said this (22:22)
- [a] 16. According to Acts chapter 22: verse 7, what did a voice say?
A. "Saul! Saul! Why do you persecute me?" (22:7)
- [s] 17. Situation question: Who said it, to whom, and what was the reply: "What shall I do, Lord?"
A. Paul [OR Saul] said it to the voice [OR the Lord] and the Lord said, "Get up and go into Damascus. There you will be told all that you have been assigned to do" (22:10)
- [g] 18. Who asked, "What are you going to do?"
A. The centurion (22:26)
- [g] 19. When did Paul fall into a trance?
A. When he returned to Jerusalem and was praying at the temple (22:17) **
- [g] 20. Who answered, "Yes, I am"?
A. Paul (22:27)

A. Alarmed (22:29)
- [s] 2. Situation question: Who said it, and what was the result: "Brother Saul, receive your sight!"?
A. Ananias said it and at that very moment Paul [OR Saul] was able to see him (22:13)
- [g] 3. How should you **wash** your sins away?
A. Calling on his name (22:16)
- [g] 4. To what did Paul persecute the followers of this Way?
A. Their death (22:4) **
- [g] 5. What did Paul hear a voice say to him?
A. "Saul! Saul! Why do you persecute me?" (22:7)
- [g] 6. What was the crowd throwing off?
A. Their cloaks (22:23)
- [a] 7. According to Acts chapter 22: verse 9, who saw the light?
A. Paul's companions (22:9) **
- [g] 8. What would Paul be told in Damascus?
A. All that he had been assigned to do (22:10)
- [g] 9. Who ordered the chief priests and all the members of the Sanhedrin to **assemble**?
A. The commander (22:30) **
- [a] 10. According to Acts chapter 22: verse 8, what did Paul ask?
A. "Who are you, Lord?" (22:8)
- [g] 11. In what did the crowd hear Paul speak to them?
A. Aramaic (22:2)
- [a] 12. According to Acts chapter 22: verse 15, what will Paul be?
A. His (God's) witness to all people of what he seen and heard (22:15)

A. 1) Tarsus of Cilicia, and 2) Jerusalem (22:3)

A. About noon (22:6) **

A. "Lord, these people know that I went from one synagogue to another to imprison and beat those who believe in you" (22:19)

A. The brilliance of the light (22:11) **
- [g] 17. By whom was Ananias highly respected?
A. All the Jews living there (22:12) **
- [a] 18. According to Acts chapter 22: verse 20, what did Paul do standing there?
A. Gave his approval and guarded the clothes of those who were killing Stephen (22:20)
- [s] 19. Situation question: Who said it, to whom, and when: "Is it legal for you to flog a Roman citizen who hasn't even been found guilty?"
A. Paul said it to the centurion standing there as they stretched him out to flog him (22:25) **
- [g] 20. To whom did the centurion go and **report** this?
A. The commander (22:26)

A. His companions (22:11)

A. Get up, be baptized and wash your sins away, calling on his name (22:16)
- [g] 4. Who was the Lord's **martyr**?
A. Stephen (22:20) **
- [g] 5. Who **withdrew** immediately?
A. Those who were about to interrogate Paul (22:29) **
- [x] 6. Two-part question: Where was Paul born, and where was he brought up?
A. 1) Tarsus of Cilicia, and 2) Jerusalem (22:3)
- [g] 7. Who will send Paul far away to the Gentiles?
A. The Lord (22:21) **
- [a] 8. According to Acts chapter 22: verse 17, who fell into a trance?
A. Paul (22:17)
