- [a] 1. According to Ephesians chapter 4: verse 13, what will we become?
A. Mature (E4:13)
- [v] 2. Finish these verses: "In your anger do not ...
A. ... sin": Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, and do not give the devil a foothold. (E4:26-27)
- [g] 3. Along with what should you get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander?
A. Every form of malice (E4:31)
- [g] 4. What must anyone who has been stealing do?
A. Steal no longer, but must work, doing something useful with their own hands (E4:28)
- [g] 5. From what are the Gentiles separated?
A. The life of God (E4:18)
- [r] 6. Finish these verses and give the reference: There is one body and ...
A. ... one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all. (E4:4-6)
- [g] 7. In what will we grow to become the mature body of him who is the head?
A. Every respect (E4:15)
- [a] 8. According to Ephesians chapter 4: verse 14, what are we?
A. Infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming (E4:14)
- [g] 9. Who gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers?
A. Christ himself (E4:11)
- [g] 10. What is being corrupted by its deceitful desires?
A. Your old self (E4:22)
- [q] 11. Quote Ephesians chapter 4: verse 32.
A. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.
- [x] 12. Six-part answer: In Ephesians chapter 4, of what does Paul say there is one?
A. 1) One body, 2) one Spirit, 3) one Lord, 4) one faith, 5) one baptism, and 6) one God and Father of all (E4:4-6)
- [g] 13. What is that not, however?
A. The way of life you learned (E4:20)
- [g] 14. What may benefit those who listen?
A. What is helpful for building others up according to their needs (E4:29)
- [a] 15. According to Ephesians chapter 4: verse 21, what were you?
A. Taught in him in accordance with the truth that is in Jesus (E4:21)
- [b] 16. In what book and chapter is the following: "But to each one of us grace has been given as Christ apportioned it"?
A. Ephesians 4 (E4:7)
- [g] 17. To what did Christ also descend?
A. The lower, earthly regions (E4:9)
- [g] 18. With what were you taught to be made new in the attitude of your minds?
A. Regard to your former way of life (E4:22-23)

A. On high (E4:8)

A. With regard to your former way of life (E4:22-24)

A. The truth that is in Jesus (E4:21)
- [r] 2. Finish this verse and give the reference: Make every effort to keep ...
A. ... the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace. (E4:3)
- [g] 3. Of what are the Gentiles full?
A. Greed (E4:19)
- [g] 4. Who gave the prophets?
A. Christ himself (E4:11)
- [a] 5. According to Ephesians chapter 4: verse 15, what is Christ?
A. The head (E4:15)
- [q] 6. Quote Ephesians chapter 4: verse 2.
A. Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love.
- [x] 7. Complete, in essence, the verse that contains the unique word "corrupted."
A. "You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires" (E4:22)
- [a] 8. According to Ephesians chapter 4: verse 18, what are the Gentiles?
A. Darkened in their understanding and separated from the life of God (E4:18)
- [g] 9. What should you not do in your anger?
A. Sin (E4:26)
- [g] 10. What does Paul urge you to live?
A. A life worthy of the calling you have received (E4:1)
- [g] 11. In what is the new self created to be like God?
A. True righteousness and holiness (E4:24)
- [a] 12. According to Ephesians chapter 4: verse 10, where did he ascend?
A. Higher than all the heavens (E4:10)
- [b] 13. In what book and chapter is the following: "From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work"?
A. Ephesians 4 (E4:16)
- [g] 14. How were you taught to be made new in the attitude of your minds?
A. With regard to your former way of life (E4:22-23)
- [g] 15. In whom does Paul insist that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their thinking?
A. The Lord (E4:17)
- [g] 16. How were you sealed for the day of redemption?
A. With the Holy Spirit of God (E4:30)
- [a] 17. According to Ephesians chapter 4: verse 25, what should you put off?
A. Falsehood (E4:25)
- [g] 18. Why did Christ himself give the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers?
A. To equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up (E4:11-12)
- [v] 19. Finish this verse: Do not let any unwholesome ...
A. ... talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen. (E4:29)
- [g] 20. Whom should you not give a foothold?
A. The devil (E4:27)
