A. Greetings (C4:11) \*\*

[g] What have the only Jews from among Paul's co-workers for the kingdom of God proved?

A. A comfort for him (C4:11)

A. Justus (C4:11)

[g] What should the Colossians pray for Paul and Timothy?

A. That God may open a door for their message (C4:3)

A. Your conversation (C4:6)

A. All the news about Paul (C4:7)
