## Welcome John & Priscilla Kunkle



John & Priscilla began their service in 1999 with the Wings of Peace aviation ministry in Bolivia. John piloted the last Wings of Peace airplane from 2002 until 2008 when the aviation program was discontinued.

They returned to the United States with their family to pastor a small church in Laredo, Texas, on a temporary assignment with WGM. Living on the border, they saw a desperate need for teachers and workers at Taylor Christian School and Taylor Community Center in McAllen, Texas. They felt the Lord leading them to make the transition to McAllen when their time in Laredo ended in 2014.

The Kunkles have served nine years in McAllen. Priscilla serves as the Area Team Leader for the global workers while John has been involved in facility maintenance. He headed up the recent Taylor Transformation Project for the Taylor Community Center completed in 2022.

Returning to the Texas/Mexico Border Ministries this year, they will need the support of many to partner with them in the work. They plan to work again with the Taylor Community Center by serving the missionaries, the community, and the local churches through leadership training and discipleship for the expansion of God's kinadom.

John and Priscilla have four children, David, Jonathan (who serves with his wife Jera at Mt. Carmel High School near Jackson, Kentucky), Tianna, and Anthony.
